Sunways Solar Modules and Solar Inverters can be classified as produced in the EU

A photovoltaic plant in Italy will be eligible for a 10 percent premium (calculated on the basis of the applicable tariffs granted to a specific plant under Conto Energia IV, 2011) if the costs of investment (excluding labour costs) for such plant is comprised of at least 60 percent of the costs of components manufactured within the European Union (Article 14 point 1 letter d) of the Conto Energia IV, 2011).

On 11 July the GSE published guidelines for obtaining access to incentive tariffs together with updated technical rules related to modalities, criteria and rules for registering large power plants from June 2011 until December 2012.

Based on these guidelines, Sunways Solar Modules and Sunways Solar Inverters originate from production operations carried out by at least 60 % within the EU.

During the transitional period, which ends on 30 June 2012, our crystalline silicon modules will be considered produced in the EU because our cells are produced in the EU.

Sunways Solar Inverters can be classified as produced in the EU because product design, assembly and test are carried out in EU production sites inter alia.
